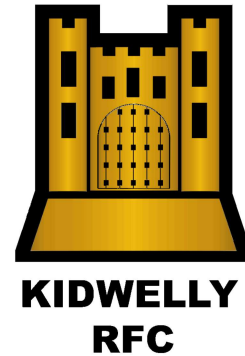


Code of Conduct Summary

The WRU Code of Conduct sets out the standards of behaviour expected from everyone involved in Welsh rugby. Its aim is to promote respect, fairness, safety, and enjoyment in the game. We have a responsibility within the club to make sure everyone, players, coaches, team managers, administrators, parents and supporters are aware of their responsibilities to the club and the game as a whole.



1. Respect for the Game

All participants must respect the laws of rugby, match officials, opponents, teammates, and spectators. Decisions made by referees must be accepted without dissent.

2. Fair Play and Sportsmanship

- Players and teams must compete honestly and fairly.
- No cheating, deliberate foul play, or unsporting behaviour.
- Winning is important, but it must never come before integrity and respect.



3. Respect for Match Officials

- Referees and officials must be treated with courtesy at all times.
- Abuse, intimidation, or harassment of officials is strictly prohibited.
- Only the team captain may approach the referee during a match when appropriate.

4. Behaviour of Coaches and Team Staff

- Lead by example and promote good sportsmanship.
- Prioritise player welfare and development.
- Avoid aggressive, abusive, or discriminatory behaviour.

5. Player Responsibilities

- Play within the laws of rugby.
- Show respect to teammates, opponents, and officials.
- Avoid dangerous play, abuse, bullying, discrimination, or harassment.
- Maintain discipline on and off the field.

6. Respect for Facilities and the Community

- Participants must respect clubs, facilities, equipment, and local communities.
- Damage, vandalism, or disorderly behaviour will not be tolerated.

7. Safeguarding and Welfare

The welfare of players, especially young people, is a priority. All participants must follow safeguarding policies and ensure rugby is played in a safe and inclusive environment.

8. Anti-Discrimination and Inclusion

Rugby must be welcoming to all. Discrimination or abuse based on race, gender, sexuality, religion, disability, or background is unacceptable.

9. Discipline and Consequences

Breaches of the Code of Conduct may result in disciplinary action by the WRU or clubs, including:

- Warnings
- Suspensions
- Fines
- Removal from competitions, roles, or club membership
